



Rules Of Hackfest'23

Codeathon

MCQ Round(Pre-qualifier round)

1. Separate qualification marks for first-year, second-year, and third-year participants.
2. Qualified participants will advance to the final round.

Final Round:

1. Participants who have qualified in the MCQ round are eligible for the final round.
2. Coding may be conducted using any programming language, as the selection is independent of a specific language.
3. First, second, and third-place winners will receive distinguished certificates of achievement and monetary prizes.

Hackathon and IoT Innovation Challenge

Idea Pitching

1. Participants must fill out a write-up to be eligible for Idea Pitching of Hackathon and IoT Innovation Challenge.
2. For first-year participants, filling out the form is not compulsory.
3. Faculty will determine qualification for this round and selection for the final round.

Final Round (IoT Innovation Challenge):

1. Participants qualified in idea pitching will have already developed their products, with 100% completion not mandatory.
2. All finalists will receive participant certificates.
3. The top three participants will be awarded certificates of recognition.
4. The winning team of the IoT Innovation Challenge will secure a one-time opportunity to participate in the upcoming technical fest at other institutes.

Final Round (Hackathon):

1. Hackathon participants will be given 12 hours to develop their products.
2. All finalists will receive participant certificates.
3. Winners of the Hackathon will receive winner certificates, and the top three participants will receive goodies.
